What does an average day look like?

- 07:00-10:00 - Arrive at the office and find out your rounds for the day, cleaning windows, raking exhibits, spot picking, prepare and deliver food.
- 10:00-10:30 - Morning Tea.
- 10:30-12:00 - Washing up, cleaning kitchen, collecting and trimming browse, cleaning & hosing dens and exhibits.
- 12:00-12:45 - Lunch.
- 12:45-14:00 - Observing training sessions, animal observations, cleaning, animal enrichment.
- 14:00-15:30 - Clean down, record keeping, animal enrichment.
