What does an average day look like?

06:40-10:00 - Arrive at the kitchen and find out your rounds for the day, food preparation, walk to section, cleaning paths, assist keepers cleaning aviaries and feeding.

10:45-11:00 - Morning Tea.

11:00-12:30 - Washing buckets, plates and bottles.

12:30- 01:15 - Lunch.

01:15-15:00 - Assist keepers with afternoon rounds, animal enrichment feeds, afternoon feeds, assist with bird observations, record keeping and final checks.
