Taronga Sydney boasts a rich history of conservation, education, and breathtaking animal experiences. Home to over 4,000 animals, the zoo is a haven for wildlife enthusiasts, offering unforgettable encounters and a commitment to global conservation.

ACTIVITIES INCLUDED IN ADMISSION

- **FREE-FLIGHT BIRD PRESENTATION** - Free Flight Birds has been showcasing the amazing natural behaviours of birds for over 20 years. Learn about the condor and other exotic birds such as the Red-tailed Black-Cockatoo and Galah, as they fly against the iconic Sydney Harbour skyline. See the presentation twice daily at 12:00 pm and 3:00pm.
- **SEALS FOR THE WILD powered by Red Energy** - Watch the graceful seals in our care catch fish, climb and dive in this dynamic display. You'll see species such as the Australian sea lion, Californian sea lion, and Long-nosed fur seal show off their natural abilities while you learn about their marine environment. See the presentation twice daily at 11:00 am and 2:00pm.
- **KEEPER TALKS** - Learn about the fascinating animals that call Taronga home from our expert Keepers. Plan your day around our daily shows and Keeper talks for an action-packed visit. Keeper Talks allow guests to discover more about their favourite animals such as the Koala. Did you know the Koala sleeps 18 to 20 hours a day?
- **NURA DIYA, AUSTRALIA** - Immerse yourself in Taronga's newest Australian experience and connect with the unique habitats and the iconic species that call them home. Nura Diya is home to our Dingoes, Koalas, Kangaroos, Wallabies, Emus and the Greater Bilby.

 - Arriving by ferry/water transfer - on arrival at the wharf guests can walk 3 minutes to the lower entrance or catch the public bus, 238 to the main entrance.
 - Arriving by public bus/car - There is a multi-story carpark as well as a public bus stop and taxi stand.
