Kit List - items you need to bring with you

- Camera flash is not permitted on wildlife after sunset
- Toiletries showers are available, toilets within walking distance and open all night
- Roar and Snore is an all-weather program –
 Please bring wet-weather gear if required
- Refillable water bottle

- Tents are 2-4 person tents (you won't have to sleep with anyone you don't know)
- All linen and towels

Where & when to meet:

Taronga's historic top entrance archway. Enter via the Zoo car park. The main entrance is adjacent to the car park and right next to the bus stop. Taronga Zoo is approximately 15 minutes by ferry from Circular Quay (Ferries depart Circular Quay at least every 30 minutes). A STA bus meets each Ferry, the first stop being the Zoo's Top Entrance. It will not be possible to enter via the Lower Entrance.

- Finish time 9.30am the following day you are welcome to spend the rest of the day exploring the Zoo
